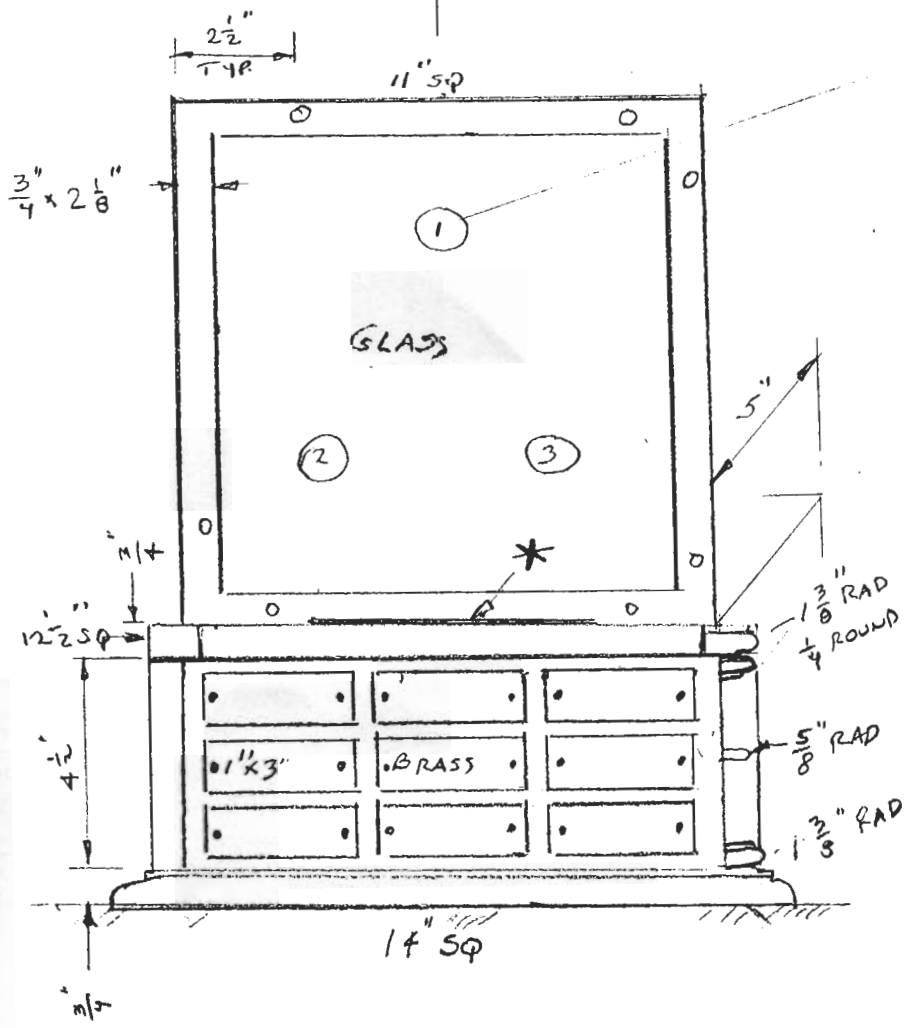

for the


**Commodore Norton W. Brooker, Jr. GYA

In order to promote and enhance the essence of the competitive spirit among sailors of the Gulf Yachting Association, this deed of gift and the Commodore Norton W. Brooker, Jr. GYA US Sailing Quarter Final Mallory Cup Trophy are presented to the GYA in honor of Commodore Brooker's dedication to the GYA, Area D and US Sailing Mallory Cup competition from 1992 through 2001. The trophy is a mahogany and glass trophy with the Blazer Patches of Mobile Yacht Club, the Gulf Yachting Association and US Sailing.


The trophy is to be competed for annually at the GYA Quarter Finals for the US Sailing Men's Mallory Cup Championship. The year and name of the winning skipper and crewmembers are to be inscribed on the trophy's base.


The trophy is to be displayed at the yacht club of the winning skipper, engraved with his name and crew and returned by the winner to the GYA Awards Banquet unless the GYA elects to take more restrictive steps to protect the trophy.

If interest in competition for the trophy does not continue, the GYA may rededicate it for another purpose.


