

***Flying Scot Mid-Winter Championship
Southern Yacht Club March 21-26, 2010***

Warm-up Regatta at New Orleans Yacht Club Sunday March 21, 2010.

As a reminder the following Flying Scot Sailing Association rules must be met in order to participate in Flying Scot Sanctioned Events.

Constitution Article IX

7. A **CLUB MEMBER** is an individual belonging to a Club/Association which owns a registered Flying Scot®. A Junior whose parent is a Club Member may sail a Club boat without paying for a second Club Membership.

Bylaw Article B-VIII

8. **Club Boats.** A Flying Scot® owned by a Yacht Club may be entered in any sanctioned event provided:

- a. A member of such club, who is a Club Member of the FSSA, is the helmsman;
- b. The club registers the boat with the FSSA annually at a fee equal to 50% of the Active Membership fee; and,
- c. All requirements for measurement in the sanctioned event are met.

Basically, if you plan on using a club owned Flying Scot, the yacht club the Flying Scot belongs to must pay dues to FSSA for that particular hull and the skipper of the hull must be also be a member of FSSA.
