NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

The Organizing Authority for this regatta shall be the Bay Waveland Yacht Club. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), and for high school sailing, the current Procedural Rules of the Interscholastic Sailing Association (ISSA).

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

OPEN CLASS--The regatta is open to Viper, VX1, Flying Scot, 420, V15, Finn, Sunfish, and one-design classes. A minimum of three (3) boats is required to constitute a One-design fleet.

HIGH SCHOOL--A high school 420 class is open to all organized high school sailing teams. For fleet racing, a team is comprised of no fewer than two and no more than four sailors who are members of the sailing team for the school they represent. Each team will sail one boat. Multiple teams (boats) from a school will be allowed. If there is sufficient interest, high school teams may break out for team racing late in the afternoon. For team racing, a team is comprised of no fewer than six sailors who are members of the sailing team for the school they represent. Each team will sail three boats. High school sailing teams are encouraged to provide their own boats. A limited number of 420s may be available from SSC-contact Dan Zwerg at dzweg@ststan.com.

3. ENTRY

Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form and remitting it together with the required fee.

4. FEES

Fees are \$20.00 for all boats.

5. SCHEDULE

Saturday, October 14

0900 – 1000 Registration – All Fleets

1000 Skippers Meeting

1100 First Warning – All Fleets

1630 No races shall start after this time

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

7. THE COURSES

The racing area will be located on the waters of Bay St. Louis. Courses will be available at the Skippers Meeting.

8. SCORING

The Low Point System of RRS Appendix A will apply. No race scores will be excluded. This changes RRS Rule A2.

9. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the top three (3) boats in each fleet depending on fleet size.

The Awards Ceremony will take place as soon as possible after the last race of the regatta.

10. LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The Bay Waveland Yacht Club will not accept any responsibility for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

11. LUNCH:

Pre-order a lunch at check-in. Otherwise, food is available from the menu.
