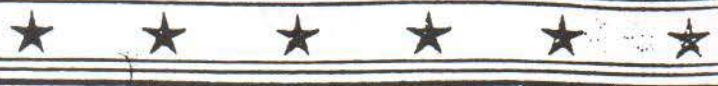

To the visiting officials, participants and guests of the Gulf Yachting Association, we extend a warm and hearty welcome.

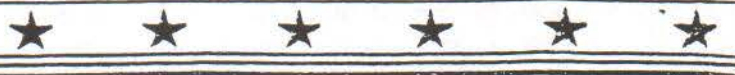

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF LIPTON

SOUTHERN YACHT CLUB—SEPT. 5, 6, & 7, 1942

COURSE

The Official Course is as shown herewith and on the Course Sheet as furnished to each skipper. The triangular course starts from the buoy in front of the club. Course numbers to be displayed when warning gun is fired.

START

The starting line is between the line flag on the Committee Boat and the buoy in front of the club.

The start will be a five-minute start, with one gun five minutes before the start, another gun two minutes before the start, and then one gun and dropping of cone at the start. If gun fails, the dropping of the cone will be the official start.

FINISH

Between the line flag on the Committee Boat and buoy in front of the club.

PROTEST

All protests, claims of fouls, or complaints shall be lodged with the Secretary of the Gulf Yachting Association, or his representative, within one hour after the completion of the race in which the alleged protest, claim of foul, or complaint occurred.

HEARING OF PROTEST

The Lipton Board of Appeals, composed of five (5) members, shall have original or exclusive jurisdiction of all fouls, complaints, and protests arising out of any race, or races, and its decision shall be final.

RESAIL OF RACE

If, for any reason, any race is ordered resailed, this race shall be resailed at 2:00 P. M. Monday, September 7th.

RACES SAILED UNDER N. A. Y. R. U. RULES

The Race Committee reserves the right to finish a race at any point of the course. If a race should be finished between two stakes, the time will be taken from the last stake the contestants have passed—and winners so determined.

POSTPONEMENT AND RECALL SIGNALS

Fish Class—3 Guns and White Flag.

Prior to Start, above signal will be for postponement.

After Start, above signal will be for recall.

All races will be started at time appointed on schedule, but may be postponed by Race Committee in charge at their discretion, and all participants in the race to be advised. Postponement and recall will be for 15 minute intervals; i. e., either 15 minutes, 30 minutes, or 45 minutes.

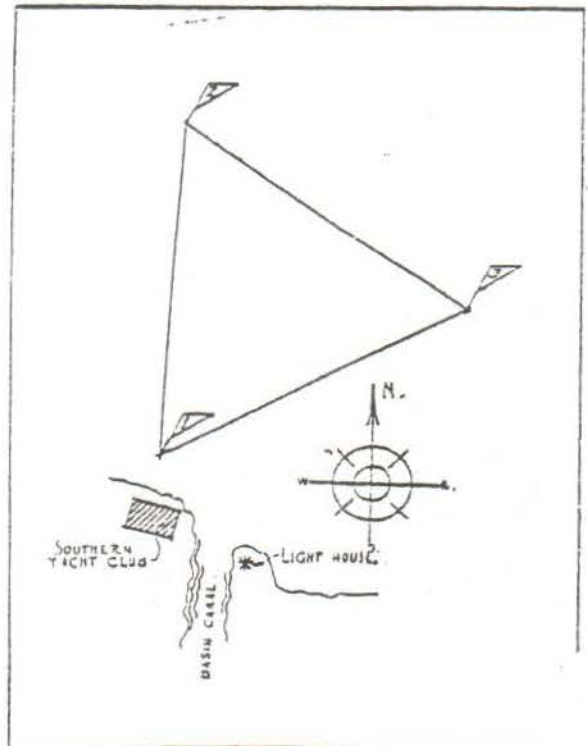
