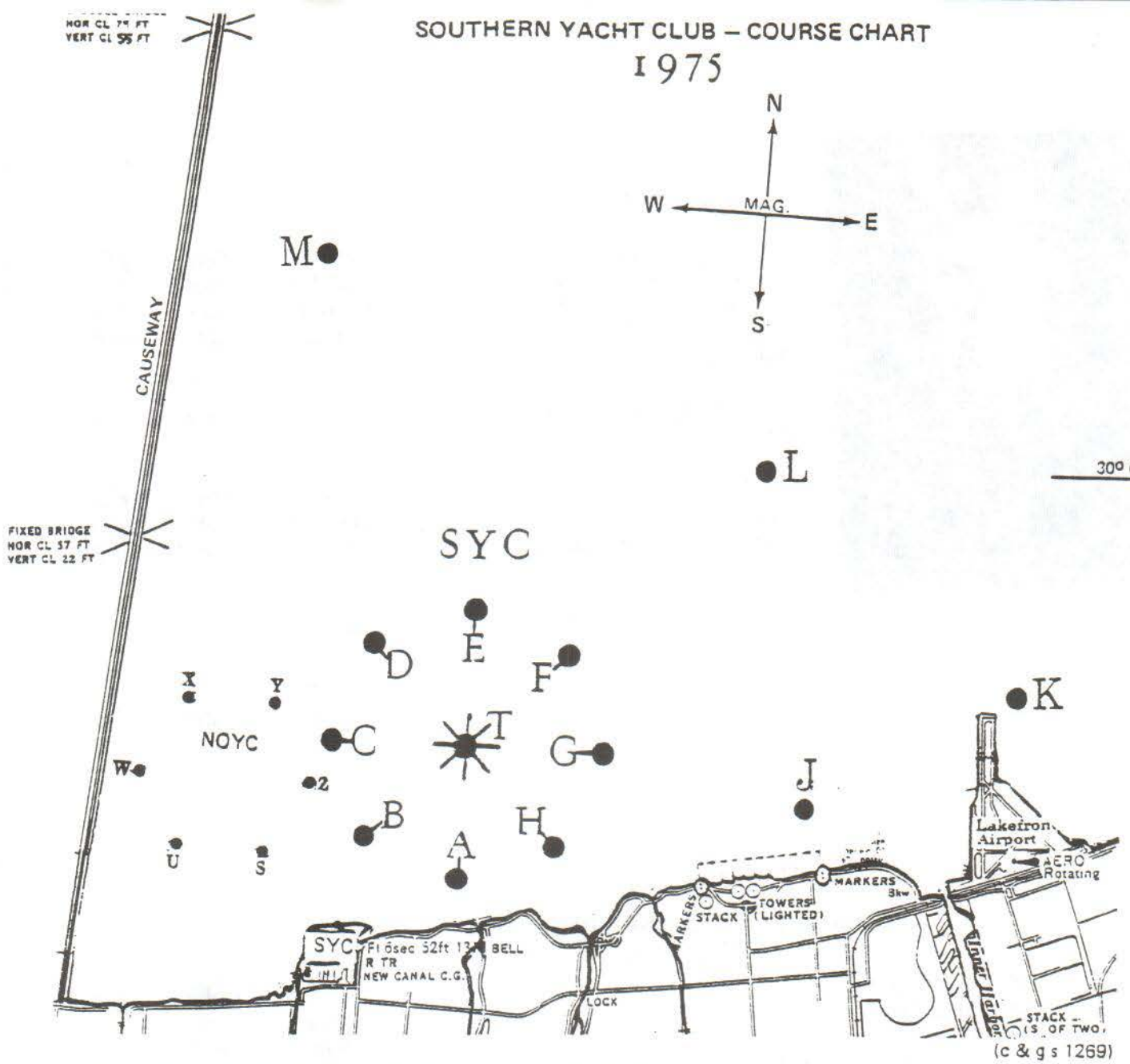
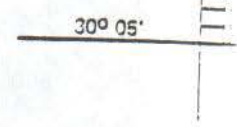
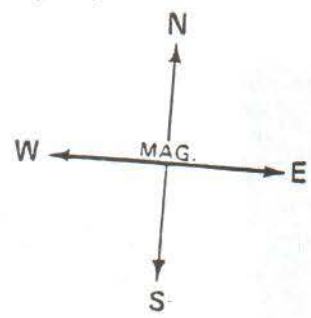

All marks are painted reddish-orange and have reflectors on four sides.
