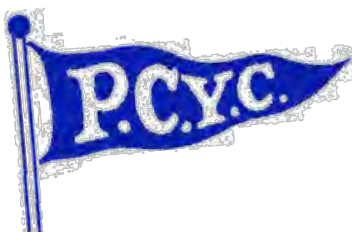

A Tribute to Sir Thomas Lipton

Born in Glasgow in 1850, Sir Thomas Lipton was best known for the tea that bears his name and for his indomitable spirit in attempting to win the "America's Cup" in his famous *Shamrocks*. Some of the things you may not know about the man perhaps deserve being mentioned since this regatta bears his name.

As a boy, he was a cabin boy in the merchant fleet, worked in a New England grocery store, drove a mule-drawn streetcar in New Orleans, traveled for a portrait firm, labored on tobacco plantations in South Carolina and Virginia and, while still in his teens, returned to Scotland to open his own grocery store.

He was an innovator in publicity stunts for advertising, once having a parade of pigs dressed in kilts to advertise his Scottish bacon and occasionally hiding sovereigns in his cheese and tea bags to spur sales. This flair for merchandising led him to be a millionaire by the age of twenty-one.

Yachts were his passion and he built and owned several; the most famous, of course, were the five *Shamrocks* he built to challenge for the America's Cup. They made unsuccessful attempts in 1899, 1902, 1903, 1920 and 1930, with *Shamrock IV* coming the closest to winning when it competed with Cornelius Vanderbilt's *Resolute* in 1920.

Though Sir Thomas never emerged victorious in the America's Cup Challenge, he gained the admiration and respect on both sides of the Atlantic for the sportsmanship he demonstrated in his losing efforts. This was best demonstrated by the fact that following the 1930 event, a Lipton Loving Cup Fund was established and in 1930 Will Rogers presented an 18 carat gold cup to Sir Thomas on behalf of the American people for his good sportsmanship...the same year the Royal Yacht Club of England conferred membership on Lipton in recognition of what he had done for yachting in his various America's Cup challenges.

Those of us who have been participants or spectators in the Labor Day weekend Lipton Regatta over the years, are likewise, indebted to Sir Thomas for having made yachting more meaningful to the yacht clubs of the Gulf Yachting Association thru his presentation of the Lipton Challenge Trophy. And may we suggest, that sometime before the regatta ends, each of you "hoist one" in memory of Sir Thomas, the man whose trophy we sail for this weekend.

Perpetual Trophies Awarded at the Lipton Regatta

SIR THOMAS J. LIPTON INTERCLUB CHALLENGE CUP

Presented to the Southern Yacht Club by the great tea magnate, Sir Thomas Lipton, in 1919 as a challenge trophy. Following Lipton's wish, Southern Yacht Club offered the Trophy for interclub races between clubs in the Gulf Coast Area. This was followed by the first challenge in October 1920, the beginning of the now 97 year old competition for this yacht-racing prize. The Lipton Cup is competed for by clubs in the Gulf Yachting Association. The trophy was allowed to travel from winning club to winning club until 1974, when for protection purposes, Southern elected to display the trophy in its clubhouse and arranged for a half -model to be cast. The half-model now travels and can be displayed at the winning club.

The exquisite Cup, too delicate and valuable to withstand considerable handling, remain on display at Southern Yacht Club until it was tragically destroyed by fire on August 29, 2005. The new sterling silver Lipton Trophy was presented to Southern Yacht Club by The Lipton Company in 2008.

SIR THOMAS J. LIPTON INTERCLUB CHALLENGE CUP HALF MODEL

Presented to the yacht club successfully challenging for, or defending its possession, of the cup. Donated to the GYA by Southern Yacht Club in 1974, this trophy provides an exact replica of the actual Lipton Cup it represents.

FLOYD DAVIS MEMORIAL TROPHY

Awarded to the winning skipper of the First Race. Donated to the GYA by St. Andrews Bay Yacht Club in 1985, in recognition of Floyd Davis's contribution to sailing and the GYA.

J. FRED CLERC TROPHY

Awarded to the winning skipper of the Second Race. Donated to the GYA by his family in 1989, in recognition of Fred Clerc's intense and highly successful participation in GYA interclub racing, particularly in the Fish Class.

COMMODORE MICHAEL S. JOHNSON TROPHY

Awarded to the winning skipper of the Third Race. Donated to the GYA by Past GYA Commodore Lewis B. Pollack, Sr. in 1989, in recognition of Michael Johnson's service to the Gulf Yachting Association.

COMMODORE LARRY BEAUVAIS, JR. MEMORIAL TROPHY

Awarded to the winning skipper of the Last Race. Donated to the GYA by Mobile Yacht Club in 1965 in recognition of Commodore Beauvais' contributions to sailing and the GYA. Commodore Beauvais served as Commodore of the GYA in 1958, but it was his finish in the last race of the 1956 Lipton Regatta that won the series for Mobile Yacht Club and inspired his friends to remember him in this special way.

TIM MURRAY MEMORIAL TROPHY

This trophy is presented annually to the most improved GYA team at the Sir Thomas Lipton challenge. The winning team must not have placed in the top 5 in the previous year's regatta. The trophy will reside at the home of the winning team and shall be returned at the next Sir Thomas Lipton Challenge competition.

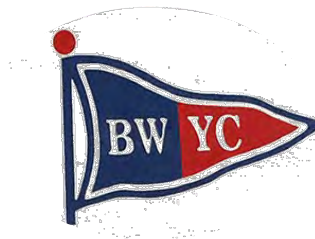
SIR THOMAS LIPTON INTER-CLUB SPORTSMANSHIP TROPHY
