GYA Regulation 24.1 has been changed as Pensacola Yacht Club Host of event.

Eligibility and Entry

The GYA Fish Class Championship is open to all GYA General Member Clubs. Notification has been made in accordance with GYA Regulations for Sanctioned Events. Approved on 1-10-2021. Boats will be provided by Pensacola Yacht Club and individual owners. Each Club wishing to participate shall return their Application to Compete via email (mark.caraher@gawest.com) not later than October 13th, 2021. Results of the Competing Clubs Selection will be emailed not later than October 15th, 2021, to all Clubs returning Applications.

Note: **Each team member shall be a member of the GYA club he or she represents.**

One Skipper and Two crews are required for all Three Races.

A different team member shall Skipper each race.
