Rules:

The Regatta is organized under the authority of The Gulf Yachting Association, and in conjunction of the Host Pensacola Yacht Club. This Event will be governed by the current edition of the [Racing Rules of Sailing](#) (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, the GYA Regulations for Sanctioned Events (available at www.gya.org.) the Notice of Race, and the Fish Class Rules, except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions.

Specific rules for this regatta are contained in GYA Regulation 24.

Eligibility and Entry:

The GYA Fish Class Championship is open to all GYA General Member Clubs. Boats will be provided by Pensacola Yacht Club. Each Club wishing to participate shall return their Application to Compete via email (mark.caraher@gawest.com) not later than October 8th, 2024. Results of the Competing Clubs Selection will be emailed no later than October 11th, 2024, to all Clubs returning Applications.

Schedule of Events:

Four Races are Scheduled. Two Races Saturday and Two Races Sunday. This changes GYA Event Reg 24.

Note: One Skipper and Two crews are required for all Four Races.

Sailors can Skipper One race and Crew the other races.

Non skippers may sail all races.
