The Foundation's investment position was reviewed. A motion was made and passed to put a 15% stop loss in effect as soon as possible.

A motion was made and passed to maintain a minimum balance of \$5,000 in the operating checking account with all other funds invested.

A motion was made and passed to close the Coastal Saving Account (Hurricane Fund) and open a separate Whitney Account with those funds.

The Board conducted annual review of the GYA Member cub assessment to support the GYA Foundation and based on long term financial forecasts, the Foundation Board feels the assessment is necessary until the Foundation's Investment Fund has at least \$200,000 in assets.
